BOYCOTT COMPANIES & PERSONALITIES THAT SUPPORT RADICALS.**

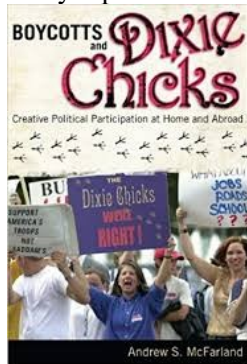
