

**NEBRASKA TAXPAYERS FOR FREEDOM ISSUE PAPER:
ILLEGAL ALIENS ARE REGISTERED TO VOTE IN U.S. ELECTIONS.**

BACKGROUND. Aliens who knowingly register to vote are a serious problem. Taxpayers are rightly concerned about illegal aliens registering to vote and voting in our national, state, and local elections. Election and other officials too often are lax about checking citizenship for registering prospective voters or purposely decline to do so. Unfortunately, prosecutors are usually too afraid or merely uninterested in enforcing the many laws against illegal alien voting. Both state and federal laws prohibit illegals from voting, but the number of prosecutors with the courage to do anything about these clear violations of law in the past decade we can count on one hand. The Left converts this lack of prosecutions into evidence that illegals are not registering to vote. No prosecutions mean no aliens voting, they say. They deflect, saying it is already illegal for aliens to vote, so move along, nothing to see here. Socialist Democrat leaders and operatives are using every ruse available to register and encourage illegal aliens to vote, because they understand that illegals likely will vote for Socialist Democrat candidates. This sordid situation explains why taxpayers must tighten voter registration procedures in their states and localities.

PRIME EXAMPLES. Oregon election officials cleaned from state voter rolls 1,200 illegal aliens who could provide no proof of citizenship. Many of them already had voted in the 2022 election. The presumed cause: Sloppy registration procedures. Later, the state Dept. of Transportation admitted mistakenly registering over 300 other illegals since 2021, citing data entry issues. Much of the problem in Oregon, like in other states, stems from allowing illegals to obtain driver's licenses, whereby the DMV automatically registers most people to vote when they obtain a license or ID card.¹ In August, 2024, Alabama, Texas, and Virginia purged over 16,000 illegal aliens from their voter rolls since 2021. The Alabama Sec. of State said his office identified 3,251 illegals



registered to vote, issued ID numbers by the Biden Dept. of Homeland Security (DHS). He instructed county boards to immediately disenroll them and plans to prosecute illegal voters. He repeatedly has questioned noncitizens voting in Alabama and claims repeated requests for assistance from the federal government have gone unanswered. "I have been clear that I will not tolerate the participation of noncitizens in our elections," he said, "I have even gone so far as to testify before a U.S. Senate Committee regarding the importance of this issue. We have examined the current voter file in an attempt to identify anyone

who appears on that list that is a noncitizen." He also has provided the list of such illegally-registered voters to the Alabama Attorney-General for further investigation and possible criminal prosecution. He continued, "This is not a one-time review of our voter file. We will continue to conduct such reviews to do everything possible to make sure that everyone on our file is an eligible voter." He remains hopeful that in the near future the federal government will change course to help states to protect our elections and recently raised concerns about the federal policy of providing voter registration forms to noncitizens. He specifically singled out the National Voter Registration Act, which requires many federal agencies to provide voter registration forms to people who use their services. This requirement includes illegal aliens. He complained that the Biden Regime decision to help illegal alien spouses and children of American citizens apply for permanent residency is proof of a presidential plot to corrupt the November election.² The situation in California has gotten worse, as the state has implemented driver's licenses for illegal aliens and automatic voter registration. California has one of the worst records in the country for failing to verify and maintain the accuracy of voter rolls.

ADDITIONAL EXAMPLES. The Virginia governor stated that his executive order removed 6,303 illegals from Jan., 2022 to July, 2024. This state used DMV records and DHS data to identify illegals.³ The governor signed an executive order implementing new election security measures. He said, "Every legal vote deserves to be counted without being watered down by illegal votes or inaccurate machines." His Executive Order 35 mandates a documented chain of custody for paper ballots, the format in which all Virginians must cast their vote. He emphasized that Virginia does not use voting machines, only paper ballots. His order also stipulates that court clerks must retain those paper ballots for

22 months. In addition, absentee ballots may not count unless the last 4 digits of a voter's Social Security number and year of birth provided on the mail in envelope match the voter record in the statewide voter registration system. Virginia is one of few states that require those registering to vote to provide their full 9-digit SSN. The order also establishes a triple-check of election result accuracy, requiring officials to check the results at the precinct level on election night, followed by a post-election review by the electoral board at the local level, and finally, a check by the Dept. of Elections staff at the state level prior to certification.⁴ A 2022 review in Georgia, which has a process for checking citizenship, found that election officials had flagged and culled about 1,600 registration applications by illegal aliens over the past 25 years.⁵ In Ohio this year, the Secretary of State identified 597 illegals on its voter rolls, including 138 who had cast a ballot.⁶ Nevada accepts alien work authorization cards as proof of identity. Millions of aliens the Biden Regime has released into the country are eligible for such cards and could register to vote in Nevada and other states with similar registration processes with little risk of detection. Because almost no state even attempts to verify that individuals registering to vote are U.S. citizens and because the federal government, including both the courts and the executive branch, have put up significant barriers to such verification, we do not really know how many aliens, whether here legally or illegally, are registering and voting. Indeed, there is almost no way we can know. Nonetheless, what we do know is very concerning and indicative of a much larger problem. Some records pertaining to alien voting are subject to the National Voter Registration Act's public disclosure provisions. The official records of aliens who contacted county election officials on their own and asked removal from the registration list *because they aren't citizens* or discovered as aliens through state driver's license records. Records reveal that 264 individuals reported or confirmed their ineligible status to government officials after registering to vote in San Diego County. In total, these individuals cast 94 ballots, some votes stretching back to the 1992 presidential election. A total of 616 admitted and officially recorded aliens in 11 counties were in the New Jersey statewide voter registration system. These, however, were only the aliens who essentially self-reported and asked for removal, 9% of whom also cast ballots before they made that request. Since 2007, Chicago city records show the sporadic removals of 394 foreign nationals from the voter registration roll. Of this group, 20 individuals cast 85 ballots.⁷

ARIZONA INACTION. The conservative action group America First Legal (AFL) sued Maricopa County, AZ., alleging that this county refused to disenroll 35,000 illegal aliens registered there, allowing them to interfere in the 2024 general election, thus violating state law. The county recorder refused to take action. The number of illegal voters in Maricopa County increases each month, the lawsuit alleges. In 2022, Arizona enacted 2 laws imposing stricter voter list maintenance requirements for voters. These laws mandate that county recorders conduct monthly checks in 3 data bases to verify citizenship and check newly-registered voters within 10 days. The county recorder failed to perform this required list maintenance by gaining access to these data bases, the lawsuit claimed. Since the 2020 election, Maricopa County has seen many controversies over election integrity and procedures. The county, a key battleground, has faced claims of widespread voter fraud, including allegations of improper ballot handling and voting machine malfunctions. In June, a temporary election worker in [that](#) county caught on surveillance video stealing a digital magnetic key to voting machines. He already faced arrest for allegedly stealing \$1,800 in cash from the register while working as a cashier at a nearby grocery store.⁸ Since 2021, government records show 186 voter registrants "involuntarily purged" over citizenship issues in Pima County, Arizona. From this group, 7 recorded as having cast ballots across 2 federal and local elections. On July 17, AFL sent all 15 Arizona counties a demand letter threatening legal action if steps not taken to stop illegal aliens from voting. On September 4, after seeing no action to remove illegal aliens from voter rolls, AFL sued all 15 counties. Officials in Arizona had discovered a flaw that allowed 97,688 voters to vote in state and local elections for years without ever providing *proof* of citizenship. This egregious error clearly proves that Arizona state election officials have failed to fulfill their voter list maintenance duties. On Sept. 17, Maricopa County Recorder Stephen Richer filed a special action in the Arizona Supreme Court, asking the court to order that all 97,688 voters transfer onto the "federal only"

voter list, thus denied a vote in state and local elections. Then he asked the court to permit all 97,688 individuals to continue to vote in state and local elections without actually proving their citizenship, a clear violation of Arizona law.⁹

FIGHT, FIGHT, FIGHT. Former President Donald Trump also repeatedly has urged redemptive measures, alleging that his opponents are irresponsibly encouraging unauthorized immigrants to vote. “A lot of these illegal immigrants coming in, they’re trying to get them to vote. They can’t even speak English. They don’t even know what country they’re in practically, and these people are trying to get them to vote,” he said. GOP lawmakers from several states, understanding that illegal alien voting is rampant, are working to stop it. Congress supposedly blocked illegals from voting in federal elections in 1996, yet illegals continue to vote. Voting in a federal election without citizenship is a federal crime punishable by imprisonment and fines. On the federal voter registration form, accepted by all states except New Hampshire and Wisconsin, prospective voters must check a box affirming under penalty of perjury that they are a U.S. citizen. The form does not require accompanying proof of citizenship but warns applicants that anyone who provides false information may face a fine, imprisonment, or deportation. One way to remedy this problem in part is for the DHS to open up our most comprehensive alien database, a system called Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements. SAVE would ensure that only U.S. citizens can vote in federal elections by requiring states to review, in-person, proof of citizenship from individuals during the voter-registration process, and to strike aliens from voter rolls. States have a right to SAVE data, but DHS makes it difficult for them to obtain it. Some states, such as North Carolina, have created more effective search protocols to verify registration eligibility. But DHS should streamline the entire process and stop putting up bureaucratic obstacles to the use of its database. We have close elections all the time in America. Anyone who doubts that should look at the database maintained by Public Interest Legal Foundation on the



hundreds of elections it has documented that resulted in ties or decided by only 1 vote.¹⁰ The House passed a new bill earlier this year, but Socialist Democrats killed it in the Senate. We must pass this legislation. The SAVE Act is both good policy and overwhelmingly popular. Requiring state election officials to verify citizenship before providing voter registration forms. Requiring an individual to provide proof of citizenship in order to register to vote in federal elections. Allowing state officials to accept a wide variety of documents verifying citizenship that will make it easy for citizens to register to vote in federal elections. Directing DHS to determine whether to conduct removal proceedings for an illegal identified as having registered to vote in federal elections. House Speaker Mike Johnson expressed similar

concerns. During a trip to Florida to meet with Trump, he said it is common sense to require proof of citizenship. “It could, if there are enough votes, affect the presidential election,” he said, “We cannot wait for widespread fraud to occur, especially when the threat of fraud is growing with every single illegal immigrant that crosses that border.” Congress must pass the SAVE Act legislation to close loopholes that allow illegal registration and voting, to enhance election security, minimize the risk of foreign interference, and restore American confidence in U.S. elections. The Act would provide states with free access to federal agency databases, so that they can remove noncitizens from voter rolls and confirm citizenship for individuals. A 2024 poll found that 87% of American citizens believe in requiring proof of citizenship before registering to vote. Over 10 million illegal aliens sneaked across our borders during the Biden Regime, and the American people rightfully demand that Congress remove the threat of illegals and noncitizens meddling in American elections. Despite the SAVE Act popularity with the American people, Socialist Democrats and their media allies continue to claim that illegal voting is both already illegal and not a serious problem. However, audits from states like Texas, Virginia, Ohio, and others have found thousands of illegals registered to vote. Socialist Dems oppose this SAVE legislation, because they want illegal aliens voting in American elections. That is why the Dems support the Biden Regime open border policies.¹¹ The House did pass the Equal Representation Act, a bill that would restore the U.S. citizenship question to the census and exclude illegals from congressional apportionment. The bill passed 206-202 on a completely party-line vote. Sen. Bill Hagerty (Tenn.) forced a vote on a similar bill in the Senate, but it failed 51-45. All of the Socialist Democrats and 1 Republican voted against it.¹²

DISLOYAL OPPOSITION. Illegal aliens are registering and voting in U.S. elections. The truth is available in public records and personal testimonies across the nation. However, leftists continue to ridicule those who expose the truth in order to perpetuate leftist lies. Liberal Democrats on the House Administration Comm. ignored or insulted hard evidence presented. Written and oral testimony documented dozens of cases of illegals registering and voting repeatedly, especially in presidential elections. There is hard evidence, not sketchy reports of aliens landing in the U.S. and voting. According to one list, 19 aliens from Italy, Mexico, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Haiti, the Philippines, Panama, South Korea, Poland, Guatemala, Nigeria, and Canada all prosecuted and convicted in North Carolina for illegally voting in multiple state elections. All these statistics brought to the attention of the House committee members. Mr. Abdelmounim in Pittsburgh wrote a letter to Allegheny County election officials begging removal from the voter rolls because, he said, “I was mistakenly registered to vote because I did not understand the



questions I was being asked” by the Pennsylvania Dept. of Transportation. 10,000 to 20,000 aliens registered to vote by PennDOT in the past 20 years. This is an admission by Pennsylvania election officials in litigation brought by the AFL. Testifiers presented similar hard, undeniable evidence of illegals voting in California, New Jersey, and, naturally, Chicago. In most instances, the aliens themselves admitted they were ineligible to vote as they begged removal from voter rolls. Many aliens are being registered to vote by election officials even after they admit ineligibility on the voter registration form. Illegals tell election officials they are not eligible to vote and still become registered. Investigators collected hundreds of examples of this across the country. Told the House committee, about 278 aliens

discovered in 2021 on the voter roll in Fairfax County, Virginia, after crosschecking of the state’s driver’s license records. A total of 117 of these confirmed aliens had voted in Virginia elections. Then taken off the voter roll, and the Electoral Board forwarded specific information on them to both the county prosecutor and the U.S. Justice Department, both of which took no action. Often, third-party registration drives by unsavory leftists tell aliens they can register and vote. The reason that the Biden Justice Dept. fails to prosecute foreign nationals who register and vote is because the agency officials with the power to do so oppose enforcing laws they dislike. The list of 278 alien voters sent by Fairfax County to the Justice Department went to, surprise, Jack Smith, the “Get Trump” Jack Smith who is now the special counsel in 2 investigations of Trump. At the time, Smith was chief of the Public Integrity Section of the DOJ’s Criminal Division, the section responsible for prosecuting federal election crimes. Apparently, he had no interest in prosecuting these blatant violations of falsely claiming citizenship to register and vote. Socialist Democrats on another House committee ridiculed another report brought to their attention as being too old, which shows how far back this problem goes. It is the official 1998 report of the House Oversight Committee of its investigation into the 1996 election contest between incumbent conservative Rep. Bob Dornan (CA), and Democrat opponent Loretta Sanchez. Sanchez won the election by a margin of only 979 votes, and Dornan mounted a challenge, claiming that aliens had illegally registered and voted. After comparing the voter registration list to subpoenaed immigration records, the House Oversight Committee found “clear and convincing” evidence that 624 aliens had voted illegally in the Dornan-Sanchez election and circumstantial evidence that another 196 aliens also had done so. Sanchez nevertheless declared the winner. The army of leftist election law professors would rather ignore this irrefutable data and continue spouting, in election law classes and at the Brennan Center, their stooge group, that alien voting hardly ever happens. They dismiss election integrity efforts like ensuring proper identification or limiting mail-in and early voting, legitimate efforts to ensure that voters are legally entitled to vote, that they do so in accordance with the law, and that their votes properly counted. They falsely label such as voter suppression. Leftist groups seem intent on fighting efforts to ensure that voter rolls contain only eligible voters. The logical inference is that they believe ineligible noncitizens would more likely vote for their candidates. A Heritage database currently records 1,500 cases of proven election fraud nationwide, and that is merely a sampling. Examining abusing absentee ballots, illegals committed a fundamental offense against our democracy, and yet most of them received only a 1-year pretrial “diversion program,” after completion of which, charges dropped.¹³

PENNSYLVANIA CORRUPTION. In Pennsylvania, election officials are still hiding records from the public about the scope of the illegal alien voting problem there and the steps they purportedly are taking to rectify it. Despite losing a federal court lawsuit in which a judge ordered the state to disclose these records, Pennsylvania officials are fighting in the hope of ignoring their statutory obligation. They are attempting to conceal documents from the public by hiding

every record of the alien registration scandal behind attorney-client privilege. No one knows exactly how many illegals voted, because Pennsylvania created an artificial attorney-client wall around all list-maintenance procedures related to its illegal voting scandal. This question now is before the 3rd U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals: Can a state hide list-maintenance records that Congress has stated should become public by simply processing them through a law office? Among the questions asked by the public and Pennsylvania state legislators that election officials are refusing to answer: How many illegal aliens registered, how many voted, who did you pay to fix the problem, and who was responsible for the mess in the first place? Instead of answering these questions, Pennsylvania election officials are asking the 3rd Circuit to overturn a district court decision ordering them to provide that information. Many of these reports, based on official data received from election officials, raise the same questions that the House Oversight Committee asked in 1998: How many aliens are registered and voting who have not contacted election officials and asked for removal from registration lists? How many aliens have not gotten a driver's license, making it impossible for election officials to use DMV records to find illegals who have registered? A total of 139 alien registrations canceled in Allegheny County through self-reporting since 2006. 27% percent of those aliens cast at least 1 ballot before removal from the voter rolls.

STATE SOLUTIONS. Conservatives are using state constitutional amendments and new laws that require citizenship verification to vote. More Republicans argue that preventing noncitizens from casting state ballots reduces the risk of fraud and increases confidence in American democracy. Over the past 6 years, Alabama, Colorado, Florida, Louisiana, North Dakota, and Ohio amended their state constitutions. In Kentucky, which along with Idaho, Iowa, and Wisconsin is now considering a constitutional amendment, illegal voting is being eliminated.¹⁴

ERODING OUR ELECTORATE. In 16 cities and towns in California, Maryland, and Vermont, plus D.C., noncitizens can vote in particular local elections, such as school board or city council. Voters in Santa Ana, CA. will decide in November to allow illegals to vote in citywide elections. In 2022, the New York State Supreme Court nullified the NYC 2021 ordinance that allowed illegals to vote in local elections, ruling that it violated the state constitution. In Vermont local elections in March, 2024, 62 illegals voted in Burlington, 13 voted in Montpelier, and 11 voted in Winooski. In Takoma Park, MD, of the 347 illegals registered to vote in 2017, 72 cast a ballot, according

to the latest data provided by the city. In San Francisco, 36 illegals registered to vote in 2020, and 31 voted.¹⁵ Conservative House members complained to the Office of Management & Budget about the lack of constitutional and statutory authority for federal agencies to engage in any activity outside the agency authorized mission, including federal voting access and registration activities exacerbated by the continued lack of transparency from federal agencies and the Biden Regime regarding the implementation of executive orders. Everyone in federal marshal custody receives a form advising them of

their right to register and vote. Providing ineligible non-citizens with information on how to register to vote undoubtedly encourages them to illegally register to vote, exposing them to legal jeopardy beyond their immigration status. An illegal alien contacted a South Carolina congressman with proof that the South Carolina Medicaid office provided her with multiple voter registration forms, even after she informed office personnel that she is not a citizen. In 2005, a GAO report found that 35 of the individuals called for jury duty from voter registration rolls over a 2-year period in only 1 U.S. district court were not U.S. citizens. Also present at that hearing was then-Kansas Secretary of State (now Attorney-General) Kris Kobach, who contended that the problem of aliens registering and voting is very real, offering evidence of 2 instances in which illegals apparently encouraged to vote in local elections, one decided by 1 vote. America First Legal (AFL) wrote to chief elections officers, secretaries of state, attorneys-general, lieutenant governors, and governors, requesting them to verify immigration statuses on voter rolls using DHS data and disenroll all illegals they find. AFL instructed that, if DHS fails to respond, they can sue in federal court to obtain the necessary information that Congress has required DHS to provide. Under the National Voter Registration Act of 1993, states must provide applicants for welfare benefits with voter registration forms that do not require proof of U.S. citizenship. The U.S. Election Assistance Commission sheet asks only for a signed attestation, under penalty of perjury, that the applicant is a citizen. AFL President Stephen Miller accused the Biden Regime of a “direct effort to sabotage the 2024 election through potential mass illegal alien voting.” 59% of illegals take advantage of at least 1 major federal welfare

benefit, such as the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), according to Census Bureau data analyzed by the Center for Immigration Studies. US Citizenship and Immigration Services (UCIS) processes its own agency identifier numbers, Form I-94 arrival or departure numbers, Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) ID numbers, naturalization cards, visa numbers or foreign passport numbers. none of which are requested on voter registration forms. However, the Help America Vote Act of 2002 requires officials to perform list maintenance of voter rolls to ensure their accuracy, which they can accomplish using the DHS Person Centric Query System database. It allows agency employees to look up individuals and quickly and easily verify their citizenship status using only a name and date of birth. It can answer all inquiries from state and local election officials about the citizenship status of all presently registered voters and all persons attempting to register to vote and do so at no cost to the states.¹⁶

A WORSE EFFECT. Even if registered illegals do not vote, their presence in the U.S. impacts federal elections. Congressional districts are the 435 areas from which we elect members to the U.S. House of Representatives. After the apportionment of congressional seats among the states, based on decennial census population counts, each state with



multiple seats is responsible for establishing congressional districts for the purpose of electing representatives. Each district must appear as equal in population to all other congressional districts in a state as practicable. The census bureau never uses the term "citizen" in that formula, because congressional districts apportioned among the states according to how many *people* reside in each state, not how many citizens live there. The more residents in a state, the more congressional districts and more seats in Congress a state receives. In turn, the number of congressional districts in a state determines how many Electoral College votes that state receives. While president, Donald Trump tried to restore the U.S. citizenship question to the 2020 census

and exclude all illegals from apportionment calculations. Unfortunately, court challenges prevented him from doing so prior to the deadline for printing and disseminating a new census form. The incoming Biden Regime then immediately terminated the effort. The Socialist Democrat Party and the states they dominate benefit most from the population overcount. The influx of illegal aliens who have arrived in New York State thanks to the Regime border policies help New York hold onto the seats it currently holds and possibly add at least 1, but only if apportionment not limited to citizens. California and New York need the illegals to maintain their respective electoral power. When illegal aliens receive free food, housing, and medical care at taxpayer expense, most likely will vote for their Socialist Democrat benefactors. Worse, however, unless there are razor-thin margins in key states, no one likely will seek to determine how many aliens cast ballots illegally.¹⁷

MOTOR VOTER FRAUD. Nineteen states and Washington, DC. allow non-citizens to obtain driver's licenses, a move that Biden backed during his 2020 presidential campaign. When trying to verify if an individual is an illegal who has registered to vote, state officials hampered by being unable to submit driver's license numbers or other easily identifiable information to the DHS. After Cong. Bob Livingston (LA.) led Republican opposition to the nicknamed Motor Voter bill in 1993, he dubbed it "Auto Fraudo." This law requires modification and updating, its loopholes closed. In the past 20 years in Chicago, 394 noncitizens registered to vote under Motor Voter despite properly telling election officials they were not citizens. Of those, 20 cast a total of 85 ballots in elections. The average length of time that illegals there stayed on the voter rolls before errors caught was 7 1/2 years. One illegal was on the rolls for 30 years! This problem is not unique to Chicago. In Virginia overall, 5,556 noncitizens cancelled from motor voter rolls, but only after 7,474 votes cast illegally.¹⁸ The 1993 National Voter Registration Act, known as "Motor Voter," intended to make it easier for U.S. citizens to register to vote when they applied for or renewed a driver's license. However, Motor Voter also made it easier for illegals to accidentally or purposefully enter voter rolls. In December, 2022, the Reno Gazette Journal reported that if applicants applying for a Nevada driver's license check the box saying they are eligible to vote, their information immediately goes to the Nevada secretary of state for registration. The Washoe County Registrar's Office told the Gazette Journal that it is possible for an illegal to register by falsely claiming

citizenship, though this is a felony. Sometimes, illegals simply do not understand the language in the motor voter registration process at the DMV and improperly register.
